



Setting up EdLink Reports



Steps for Successful Uploads

1. Get security credentials for EdLink sFTP server
2. Whitelist your server that will be used to upload the extracts
3. Create a remote connection to the EdLink sFTP server
4. Schedule each extract to run on a regular basis

1. Security Credentials for EdLink

- Credential are needed to access sFTP server and create remote connection
- Security Coordinator needs to email LDOE_LEA_Support@powerschool.com
- In subject line, include the Sponsor Code and Name
- In body of the email, include any other pertinent information (e.g. identify other technical contacts and/or vendors who may need credentials, list the sponsor codes and sponsor names if support is provided for multiple school systems, etc.)
- Direct questions about credentials to EdLink360@la.gov

2. Whitelist your server

- IP Address of the server that will be used to drop extracts on the PowerSchool sFTP must be whitelisted
- Hosted PowerSchool districts to work with Support to get their IP address
- Security Coordinator needs to email LDOE_LEA_Support@powerschool.com
- In subject line, include the Sponsor Code, Name and IP Address or range of IP addresses
- In body of the email, include any other pertinent information (e.g. identify other technical contacts and/or vendors who may require whitelisting of their IP Address(es))
- Home or private IP addresses cannot be whitelisted.

3. Create Remote Connection to EdLink

- Select **Remote Connection Manager** option under System/ System Settings/ Plugin Management Configuration
- Click on Remote Connection Manager at bottom of screen to get to screen to create new connections

Create Remote Connection to EdLink

As of April 2021, the connection values are as follows:

- Protocol = SFTP
- Host = 13.65.236.122
- Port = 22
- Authentication Type = Password
- Finger Print = e4:6d:ac:a1:ef:14:0a:40:46:5b:89:54:d1:7b:06:20
- Remote Path = File_Extracts
- Allow download = checked
- Allow upload = checked

4. Schedule Extracts

- Extracts should be run from District level and include all schools that are to be reported in a single file
- Files should be uploaded to the EdLink server by 7:00 PM to be processed overnight
- Most extracts should be uploaded nightly
- Each EdLink extract has a prompt to select the Remote Connection to use for the automatic upload to the EdLink server
- Use the PowerSchool Scheduling option within the report to schedule the generation on a regular basis

4. Schedule Extracts

- Each Output File name option needs to be scheduled separately
- School Year is determined by the year selected at the top right of screen
- Use SFTP connection dropdown to select the EdLink remote connection you set up in Remote Connection Manager

4. Schedule Reports



- At bottom of the report parameter page, select 'Schedule' instead of 'Run Now'
- Under Schedule Settings, select 'Repeat' and specify the frequency of the repeats and when to start
- Identify the time the extracts should be run
- When completed, press Submit
